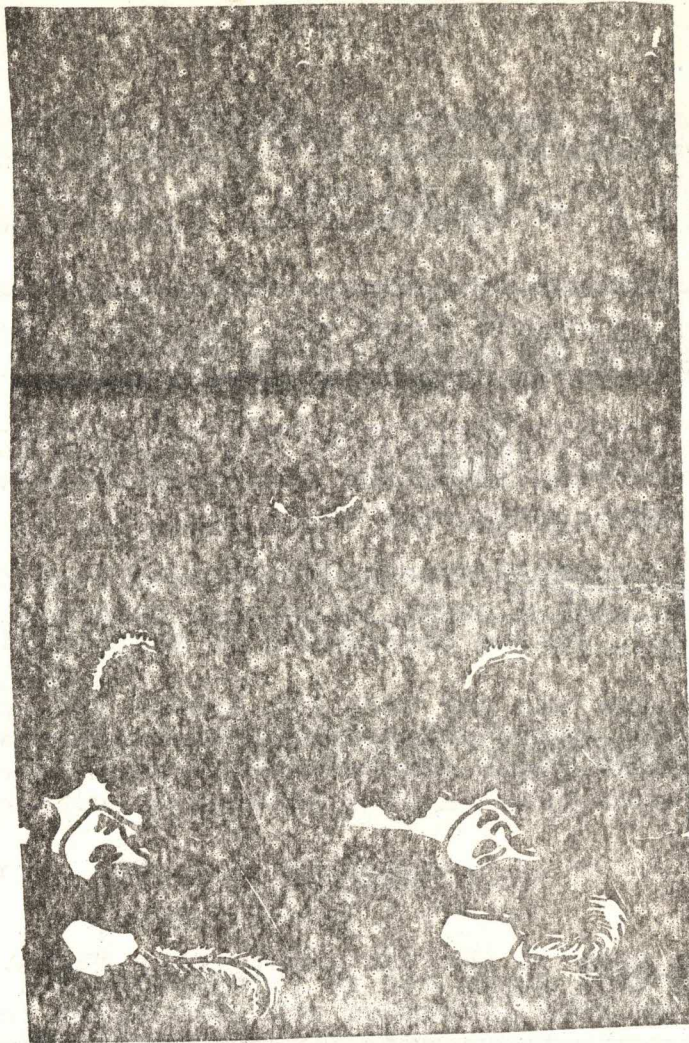

KEEP ON TRUCKING

Opening this week (Thurs. 22nd) is the most entertaining and unusual show of the year - "Miss Litchfield's RIVERINA FOLLIES" at the Trucking Co. Theatre - South Campus. The Trucking Co. have been lucky enough to meet up with the amazing Miss Rose Litchfield, a veteran theatrical trouper, who has been touring her own shows, in all parts of the world (including Zanzibar!) for many years. Before she went overseas she was famous for her rollicking shows presented in the Riverina.

The result of Miss Litchfield's becoming Guest Director for the Trucking Co. is a unique and wildly entertaining show, written by the cast (which includes the Company's usual Director Terry O'Connell), and guaranteed to reveal to you many of those "ructions in the riverina" which have taken place since the place was discovered up until now. The normal Trucking Co. energy and vitality is very much in evidence, and several of the cast have emerged as surprisingly talented musical composers, as you will realise when you hear the 17 original songs !

"Follies" runs Thurs. 22nd - Sun. 25th Sept. - and
Thurs. 29th Sept. - Sun. 2nd October.

On the Friday, Sat. and Sun. of the second week (30th Sept. - 2nd Oct.) there is a LATE SHOW at 11, consisting of the highly controversial adult drama "Mates" (see back page of 'RACE').

Both these shows are most highly recommended, and remember, the 1ST WEEK is better to see Follies because (a) Gordon Beattie's superb production of "The Threepenny Opera" runs concurrently with "Follies'" second week, and

(b) EVERY Trucking Co. production SO FAR has had full houses in the second week and many people have had to be turned away.

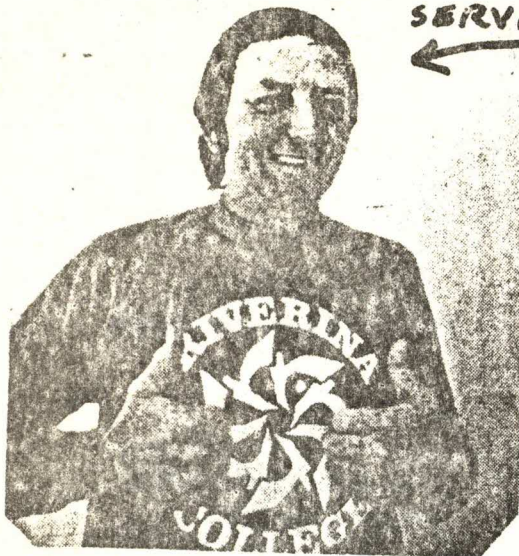
