CO-OP

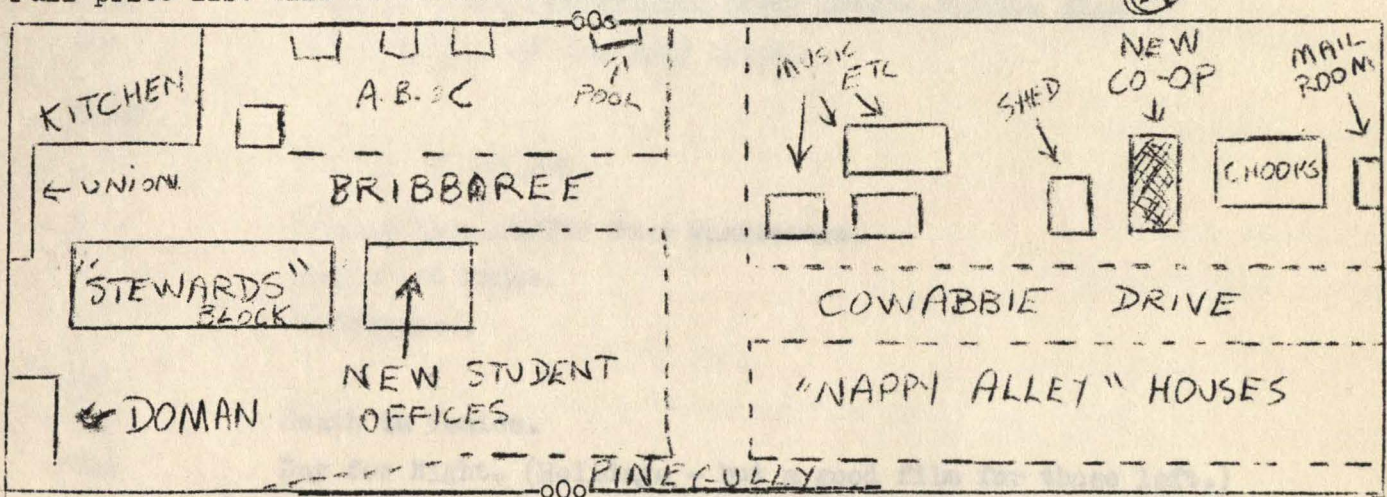
