Our history

Our ethos, yindyamarra winhanganha, has been part of the Charles Sturt University narrative from the very start. Our history dates back more than 125 years, to the establishment in 1895 of a vocational farm at Bathurst designed to give rural people access to skills and education.

Over subsequent decades, agricultural and teaching centres were set up in Wagga Wagga and Bathurst, disseminating knowledge so individuals could improve their prospects and better serve their communities.

Charles Sturt University officially became a university in 1989, merging the former Mitchell College of Advanced Education and the Riverina-Murray Institute of Higher Education, and incorporating educational facilities at Albury-Wodonga, Bathurst and Wagga Wagga.

Since then we have continued to grow, and now give students from across Australia and the world access to quality university education.

Today we have campuses in Albury-Wodonga, Bathurst, Dubbo, Orange, Port Macquarie and Wagga Wagga. We also have study locations in Canberra, Goulburn, Parramatta and Wangaratta.

Our delivery of world-class online education is informed by more than 50 years of experience in distance learning. The majority of our degrees can now be studied online.

We have unique partnerships with a wide variety of organisations, including TAFE providers, the NSW Police Force, the Anglican Diocese of Canberra and Goulburn, the New South Wales Department of Primary Industries, Commercial Radio Australia, the Islamic Sciences & Research Academy of Australia, and universities in China and Sri Lanka.

We also have many partners around the world, enabling our students to undertake international study experiences, further expanding their horizons.

The man from whom the university takes its name – Charles Napier Sturt – was a British soldier who sailed to the colony of New South Wales in 1827 to pursue his passion for exploration.

The university mace

The Charles Sturt University mace is the symbol of the university as an independent academy of scholars constituted under legal authority.

The mace is crafted from timbers indigenous to the locations of Charles Sturt University campuses. It reflects the traditions and authority of the university, and symbolises its multiple geographies and responsibilities to the people of rural and regional Australia.



The university message stick

A gift from Dubbo City Council, this wooden message stick draws on elements of local indigenous culture to represent the entire Wiradjuri nation, whose borders encompass our campuses at Albury-Wodonga, Bathurst, Dubbo, Orange and Wagga Wagga.




























Young and old emu feathers, which hang from the mulga wood message stick, denote students of all ages. A possum painting represents the local Wilay Wiradjuri people and red ochre lines depict the Macquarie, Murrumbidgee and Murray Rivers on which the university's Albury-Wodonga, Bathurst, Dubbo and Wagga Wagga campuses are located.



Coat of Arms

The Coat of Arms bears the arms of the university at the centre. The helm sits above the arms showing a knight's helmet crowned with three golden stars atop which sits the crest – a lion holding three keys. The mantling is dressed in green and gold at either side of the helm and arms. 'For the Public Good', Charles Sturt University's motto, is inscribed to the motto scroll at the base of the arms.

The graduation ceremony

The Academic Senate recommends students to be admitted to degrees. Those students (known as graduands) will have successfully completed a course of study and the prescribed examinations. The University Council formally admits the graduands, approving conferral of award as graduates.

The university medals

Undergraduate University Medal

Awarded to our graduates from a bachelor's degree, in which at least 64 points of study in the course were completed at this university and whose GPA was 6.75 or higher.

Postgraduate University Medal

Awarded to our graduates from a coursework master's degree, in which at least 64 points of study in the course were completed at this university and whose GPA was 6.75 or higher.

Bachelor Honours University Medal

Awarded to one Honours graduate per faculty, who has completed at least 64 points of study in the course at the university, and who has achieved Class 1 as an overall grade for the Honours course. At least one examiner must indicate that the student's thesis or dissertation is at a level consistent with the award of a university medal.

Higher Degree by Research University Medal

Awarded to one doctoral and one master's by research graduate per faculty. At least two examiners must indicate that the graduate's thesis is at a level consistent with the award of a university medal.

Charles Sturt Medal

Awarded to one graduate annually who has both an outstanding academic achievement (including a GPA of 6.75 or higher), and has demonstrated a significant contribution to the public good consistent with the university's motto 'for the public good'.

Bachelor of Nursing

Tammy O'Connor admits she is one of those rare and lucky people who knew early on how she wanted to make a real and lasting impact on this world.

"I studied a Bachelor of Nursing at Charles Sturt University and I knew as soon as I started that I wanted to become a midwife. To me it seemed like such an awesome career.

"After graduating I worked as a registered nurse and quickly enrolled in the Graduate Diploma of Midwifery at Charles Sturt while working in the maternity unit as a student midwife. The uni gave me a great platform to learn in a safe environment, and provided a good stepping stone into my career. That's why I completed a Master of Midwifery through Charles Sturt University. It opened the door to those higher level positions, including my current role as a clinical midwifery consultant for the Western NSW Local Health District.

"The beauty of nursing and midwifery is it can take you anywhere."

Tammy's 'anywhere' turned out to be parts of NSW which rarely received the health and educational support services they required. Realising women in remote areas needed access to antenatal and postnatal care, Tammy has been instrumental in implementing an outreach maternity program.

"I believe it's a basic human right for women to access a midwife during their pregnancy, regardless of their location. Working and living regionally provides me with the opportunity to work within the primary healthcare model of midwifery. It's what I love!"





Courtney Glazebrook

Bachelor of Education (Birth to Five Years)

Courtney Glazebrook is creating new beginnings by treasuring the past. Passionate about First Nations education, she is driven to make a difference in the lives of young Aboriginal children by giving them the best start to their educational journey. As the director of Towri Multifunctional Aboriginal Children's Service, each day, when she opens the Towri doors, Courtney makes practical progress in her quest to cultivate a strong, connected and inclusive community.

"Towri encompasses health, education, community engagement and family support. Early childhood care has such great flow-on effects for families. While we're providing care for children we're also building platforms for parents, giving them the opportunity for employment and better health. We are building the capacity of whole communities. When children thrive so do communities.

"I have the opportunity to create tangible change. What we do, what we teach and what we advocate for directly impacts upon the community and everyone in it. I have learned, through my Charles Sturt University studies and through my career, to question different regimes of truth.

"Aboriginal people are strong. We are connected. We are progressive. And at Towri we are creating new beginnings for those who come through. That really excites me."

Chandan Rauniyar has long been fascinated by the power of computing and the impact it can have on people's lives.

"I have always been amazed by computers and what complex software could do. I was interested in software development and it seemed like such an awesome career – being able to develop complex computer software that is capable of transforming lives.

I majored in software development, learning about the principles of software development, data structures, and database design, as well as the ethics and security issues around computing."

Seeking to serve the Lebanese Christian community: Exploring the evangelical ministry in the Sydney diaspora

This thesis explores the practice of ministry of the first Lebanese Arabic-speaking evangelical minister in the Uniting Church. It provides an example of what ministry is like for a migrant who steps out of a monoculture into ministry in one of the most multicultural cities in the world and is confronted with a church culture that allows for the baptism of infants, the ordination of women and is more liberal towards same-gender relationships.

Kamaloni Tu'iono

Seeking to Create 'VA' Spaces as a Means of Fostering a Communal Model of Supervision in a Cross-cultural Setting

This thesis draws upon Tongan cultural customs in order to propose a communal model of supervision for faifekau (ministers) in the Uniting Church. Its Code of Ethics allows for diverse cultures to compose modes of oversight that are particular to their cultures. The relevant paragraph, 1.8, has not been put to such use to the disadvantage of island ministers. The default practice is to privilege a 1 on 1 practice rather than one that is community-based.

Doctor of Philosophy

Mir Sadeq Ansari

The Role of 'Aql in Determining the Rules of Matn Criticism in al-Ṭaḥāwī's Sharḥ Mushkil al-Āthār

This research explores al-Ṭaḥāwī's (d. 933) rules when conducting content criticism of hadith in his magnum opus *Sharḥ mushkil al-āthār*. Specific types of content criticism (such as Arabic hermeneutics, logical fallacies) was studied in order to extract the criteria under which al-Ṭaḥāwī applies them. This research demonstrates the dynamic role that reason enjoyed with al-Ṭaḥāwī and highlights the significance of the *ikhtilāf al-ḥadīth* (problematic hadith) genre.

Mary Elizabeth Coe

How readers make sense of active e-book indexes

E-books are the latest form of book technology and can be in a reflowable format without pages that include active indexes hyperlinked to a paragraph, line, or word in the text. This study explored how readers make sense of active indexes. Findings suggest that people's expectations and mental models of e-books are different from those of print books. Recommendations are provided for creating active indexes that align with readers' information-seeking behaviour.

Belinda Jane Friezer

How do Infants Interact in Groups in Long Day Care Across the First Two Years of Life?

This research brought together key concepts of infant social development, dynamic systems theory and educators' perceptions in a mixed-methods design. The findings identified the pathway of infants' social development in peer groups, the group processes that underpin this pathway, and the motivations that underlie behaviour in groups. These understandings are crucial for educators to support infants to build considered and responsive relationships with their peers.

Cynthia Martha Ann Geppert

Addiction and the Captive Will: A Colloquy Between Neuroscience and Augustine of Hippo

This thesis conducts a dialogue between the theologian, Augustine of Hippo, and modern models of addiction. Choice, learning and brain disease models of addiction are examined in conversation with Augustine's ideas regarding the effect of sin on the human will. Augustine's doctrine of the captive will aligns with the brain disease model of addiction. This insight can bring a transcendent dimension both to the neuroscientific understanding of addiction and recovery.

Matthew John Grubits

The Crisis of Captain Moonlite: a case study of unbelief in colonial Australia

This thesis explores the religious life of Andrew George Scott, aka Captain Moonlite, during his time in Australia, from 1868 to 1880. It demonstrates that Scott was initially "sincere in his religion," as he himself claimed, but subsequently experienced a journey of unbelief, and contributes to knowledge of religious experience in the nineteenth century. This is the first extensive scholarly study of Scott, and the first work to specifically examine his religion.

Karl Logge

Mapping, Weaving, Weirding: Rethinking the radical to weird design

This thesis connects radical and speculative design methods with redirective and undisciplined thinking to defuture what-might-not-become. In the age of unsettlement, asymmetry, and the post-normal design is becoming weird. Moreover, if design is making things weird are we being weirded by design? To weird design allows design thought and action to seek radical and critical points of departure to address crises at disciplinary, social, temporal and planetary scales.

Susan Janelle Moore

Safeguarding children from sexual abuse in remote Australia: Applying a 'Both Ways' cultural approach

Both Ways Child Safeguarding is the theory identified by the Constructivist Grounded Theory (CGT) research undertaken with Aboriginal participants from Australia's Northern Territory. It is a theory for action and transformation that positions Aboriginal cultural knowledge at the forefront of safeguarding children from sexual abuse and signposts new strategies for intercultural, collaborative prevention and intervention.

Jennifer Adele O'Dempsey

The Roles and Visibility of Women in Brisbane's Social Protests 1967 - 1982

This thesis offers an oral history of women's participation in Queensland protest 1967-1982. Seventeen women explained their dissatisfaction with post-war Queensland society. They described how they altered attitudes to women's issues: sexuality, abortion, sex crimes and education. Primary sources supplemented the interviews. The research uncovers reasons for women's political activism and places them in their rightful place in the historical narrative.

Julie Ann Perrin

Sibling Bereavement When Death is Drug Related: a Qualitative Study

This research investigates three fields of practice: thanatology, drug and alcohol, and family work. The qualitative project is underpinned by Gadamer's philosophical hermeneutics. Recommendations relate to sibling bereavement, sibling drug and alcohol use, and family work; different standpoints about the same situation, make different interpretations possible. The research contributes to each field of practice, social work, and community of hermeneutic researchers.

This research study, therefore, aims to identify key psychosocial factors influencing adolescents to gravitate towards extremist messages and to develop an inventory to measure such vulnerability.

*Environmental predictors of disease risk for *Litoria raniformis* populations in south-eastern Australia.*

This thesis investigated environmental drivers of the amphibian chytrid fungus in populations of an endangered frog, *Litoria raniformis*. Drivers of infection prevalence and intensity were similar across climate zones, influenced by water temperature, pH and salinity. Combining these with age structure and survival rate produced population models that demonstrated how management could improve survival, findings which can apply to threatened frog species globally.

Yuchi Chen

*Aetiopathogenesis and Presentation Patterns in
Photosensitisation of Livestock in Australia*

This thesis investigated the relationship between hepatogenous photosensitisation and the *Panicum* grass genus. A plant survey found *P. hillmanii* to be of higher prevalence in NSW, with metabolomic profiling suggesting the potential to cause more outbreaks due to a greater toxic sapogenin profile. Together, these findings demonstrate the mechanism by which *P. hillmanii* is likely to be a leading cause of photosensitisation in livestock in South-Eastern Australia.

Kristina Margaret Griffin

*Healer or Warrior: An Historical Account of the Role Duality of
the Australian Army Medic in Warzones*

The thesis title expresses the dichotomy of the core duties of an army medic. These individuals are both a soldier bearing arms, trained in warfare, and a nurse responsible for saving lives. These themes are compared and contrasted across a century. The thesis offers a scholarly narrative of the past, offers some insights to the problems of military members in post-deployment civilian life.

Vasiti Vocea Uluviti

*Killers in our midst (Leptospires): Potential Fijian herbal remedies
for leptospirosis*

Plants of Fiji are used as medicines – are they active against bacteria that cause leptospirosis, a potentially fatal respiratory disease? A traditional medicine survey of Fiji and other Pacific nations helped identify 10 plants for study. Leaf extracts were assessed for antibacterial activity. Organic extracts of 4 plants were found to be strongly active, in vitro, against 4 *Leptospira* species. Several promising molecules were identified, most notably phytosterols.

Zahra Batool Naqvi

*Improving Sensory Characteristics and Shelf Life of Low-
Quality Beef through the Application of Sous Vide Cooking and
Ginger Protease*

Meat from older dairy animals is often characterised by poor tenderness, juiciness and flavour, resulting in low consumer preference, and remains a significant problem for the red meat industry. This research, reported in four high quality journals, concluded physical parameters, sensory characteristics, and shelf life of low-quality meat from older cows can be significantly enhanced through the combined effect of sous vide cooking and ageing with ginger protease.

*Amelioration of Subsurface Soil Acidity by Surface
Incorporation of Organic Amendment*

An organic amendment (OM) consisting of lucerne pellets was tested as an alternative method to mitigate subsurface soil acidity. It was found that surface applied OM was better than lime in increasing pH and decreasing Al³⁺ concentration in the subsurface soil layer. Also, reactions between organic anion (OA) and soil proton, oxidation of OA, nitrogen mineralisation, and nitrification were the main processes that contributed to the soil pH change after OM addition.

Cathrynne Charlotte Henshall

*The effect of exercise and acute and chronic stress on equine
learning, memory, behaviour and welfare*

Domestic horses are required to learn and repeat numerous responses, yet at the same time they are exposed to stressors and exercise that

can impact learning and memory. Cath's project revealed how the daily experiences of horses impacts their behavioural, physiological and neurophysiological cognitive processes. The findings are important in guiding the development of evidence-based horse training methods and have implications for horse welfare and rider safety.

Md Shafaet Hossen

Molecular characterisation of selected parasites from commercially important fish in south-eastern region of Australia

Parasites infecting edible fish can have significant economic, health and environmental impacts. Using a combination of morphological characteristics and DNA fingerprinting this study investigated nematodes and monogenean parasites in selected edible fish. The identification of new host species and regional occurrences of nematodes and monogenean parasites showed that the prevalence and intensity of infections may be changing in south-eastern Australian waters.

Emma Elizabeth Mary Lynch

Effects of varying inclusion levels of canola meal for grass-fed cattle

Canola meal is a useful supplement for grass-fed cattle grazing low-quality roughages, having no adverse effects on production, apparent nutrient digestibility, or consumer sensory evaluations. However, an upper limit of supplementing canola meal between 46% and 68% of dry matter intake was established when cattle were fed low quality roughages. This supplement meets approval requirements under the Pasture-fed Cattle Assurance System.

Scott Andrew McManus

Assessment of interpretation uncertainty in spatial domains using data science and bayesian approximation.

This thesis investigates methods to quantify uncertainty in mining projects which currently relies on qualitative assessments that may not be transparent for public reporting. Scott's work develops mathematical applications to quantify uncertainty, applied to real mining case studies. It is the first time this is researched and translated into a workflow that can be realistic implemented in industry to change the way mining projects are conducted and reported.

Babu Nath

Study on the biology of circovirus encoded proteins with special emphasis on pigeon circovirus

Babu's research into avian circoviruses showed how a pathogen can cross species barriers and negatively impact on individual and flock health. He also solved the atomic structures of the proteins of circoviruses including a discovery showing how the replication protein is assembled which might become useful for bioengineering applications. The new tests he developed will benefit the diagnosis of avian circovirus diseases and conservation of endangered bird species.

Richard Daniel Segal

*The effects of an island-wide rodent eradication on a threatened bird species, the Lord Howe currawong (*Strepera graculina crissalis*).*

Richard studied the effects of an island-wide rodent eradication on Lord Howe Island on a native threatened bird, the Lord Howe currawong. He found that the baiting operations during the rodent eradication immediately affected the currawong population. However, an increase in food and high breeding success following the eradication allowed a recovery of the currawong population. His research demonstrates the importance of ecological monitoring to understand the complex relationships of island species affected by rodent eradications.

Sean Damian Joseph Mack

The role of leadership in building, facilitating and sustaining a person-centred approach to working with residents, in the residential aged care environment

At its best, residential aged care is about people living, visiting, working, and thriving in a human community. By exploring the lived experience of residents, families, and staff in two remarkable aged care homes, this research discovered a possible way to realise that potential. It is about person-centredness extending from leaders and permeating through every part of the organisation that builds authentic, loving relationships with residents, family and staff.
