UNION CONSTITUTION AMENDMENTS

MOTION 1

That the following be put into the Riverina College Union Constitution: Item 1 Definitions - Section (h)

'"Separate Campus" means a campus of the College which contains an autonomous Student Organisation (for example, as at autumn semester 1978 - RCAE Albury Wodonga Students' Association).'

MOTION 2

That Item (4) Section (a) Ordinary Membership of the Riverina College Union Constitution be amended to read:

"All registered students of the College, except those enrolled at a "separate campus", shall be ordinary members of the Union upon payment of the prescribed fee."

MOTION 3

That Item 12 Section (a) The Board of the Riverina College Union Constitution be amended to read:

"Union Board of Management Members hold office for a period of Eighteen (18) months with elections being held where appropriate in "April" and "October" with half the Board retiring every Nine (9) months."

That Item 12 Section (b) The Board of the Riverina College Union Constitution be amended to read:

- (b) The Board shall be comprised of -
 - (i) "Nine/representatives of Members of the Union whom at least Five (5) shall be full-time students, all of whom shall be elected by members, in accordance with the regulations."
 - (iii) "A nominee from the College Council."

That Item 12 Section (d) The Board of the Riverina College Union Constitution be amended to read:

"The Board shall, at the first meeting after the election of the Board, elect one of it's members to be the Chairperson and another to be Vice-Chairperson and another to be Honorary Treasurer."

That Item 7 - Life Membership of the Riverina College Union Constitution be amended to read:
