Our history

Our ethos, yindyamarra winhanganha, has been part of the Charles Sturt University narrative from the very start. Our history dates back more than 125 years, to the establishment in 1895 of a vocational farm at Bathurst designed to give rural people access to skills and education.

Over subsequent decades, agricultural and teaching centres were set up in Wagga Wagga and Bathurst, disseminating knowledge so individuals could improve their prospects and better serve their communities.

Charles Sturt University officially became a university in 1989, merging the former Mitchell College of Advanced Education and the Riverina-Murray Institute of Higher Education, and incorporating educational facilities at Albury-Wodonga, Bathurst and Wagga Wagga.

Since then we have continued to grow, and now give students from across Australia and the world access to quality university education.

Today we have campuses in Albury-Wodonga, Bathurst, Dubbo, Orange, Port Macquarie and Wagga Wagga. We also have study locations in Canberra, Goulburn, Parramatta and Wangaratta.

Our delivery of world-class online education is informed by more than 50 years of experience in distance learning. The majority of our degrees can now be studied online.

We have unique partnerships with a wide variety of organisations, including TAFE providers, the NSW Police Force, the Anglican Diocese of Canberra and Goulburn, the New South Wales Department of Primary Industries, Commercial Radio Australia, the Islamic Sciences & Research Academy of Australia, and universities in China and Sri Lanka.

We also have many partners around the world, enabling our students to undertake international study experiences, further expanding their horizons.

The man from whom the university takes its name – Charles Napier Sturt – was a British soldier who sailed to the colony of New South Wales in 1827 to pursue his passion for exploration.

The university mace

The Charles Sturt University mace is the symbol of the university as an independent academy of scholars constituted under legal authority.

The mace is crafted from timbers indigenous to the locations of Charles Sturt University campuses. It reflects the traditions and authority of the university, and symbolises its multiple geographies and responsibilities to the people of rural and regional Australia.



The university message stick

A gift from Dubbo City Council, this wooden message stick draws on elements of local indigenous culture to represent the entire Wiradjuri nation, whose borders encompass our campuses at Albury-Wodonga, Bathurst, Dubbo, Orange and Wagga Wagga.




























Young and old emu feathers, which hang from the mulga wood message stick, denote students of all ages. A possum painting represents the local Wilay Wiradjuri people and red ochre lines depict the Macquarie, Murrumbidgee and Murray Rivers on which the university's Albury-Wodonga, Bathurst, Dubbo and Wagga Wagga campuses are located.



Coat of Arms

The Coat of Arms bears the arms of the university at the centre. The helm sits above the arms showing a knight's helmet crowned with three golden stars atop which sits the crest – a lion holding three keys. The mantling is dressed in green and gold at either side of the helm and arms. 'For the Public Good', Charles Sturt University's motto, is inscribed to the motto scroll at the base of the arms.

The graduation ceremony

The Academic Senate recommends students to be admitted to degrees. Those students (known as graduands) will have successfully completed a course of study and the prescribed examinations. The University Council formally admits the graduands, approving conferral of award as graduates.

The university medals

Undergraduate University Medal

Awarded to our graduates from a bachelor's degree, in which at least 64 points of study in the course were completed at this university and whose GPA was 6.75 or higher.

Postgraduate University Medal

Awarded to our graduates from a coursework master's degree, in which at least 64 points of study in the course were completed at this university and whose GPA was 6.75 or higher.

Bachelor Honours University Medal

Awarded to one Honours graduate per faculty, who has completed at least 64 points of study in the course at the university, and who has achieved Class 1 as an overall grade for the Honours course. At least one examiner must indicate that the student's thesis or dissertation is at a level consistent with the award of a university medal.

Higher Degree by Research University Medal

Awarded to one doctoral and one master's by research graduate per faculty. At least two examiners must indicate that the graduate's thesis is at a level consistent with the award of a university medal.

Charles Sturt Medal

Awarded to one graduate annually who has both an outstanding academic achievement (including a GPA of 6.75 or higher), and has demonstrated a significant contribution to the public good consistent with the university's motto 'for the public good'.

Bachelor of Nursing

Tammy O'Connor admits she is one of those rare and lucky people who knew early on how she wanted to make a real and lasting impact on this world.

"I studied a Bachelor of Nursing at Charles Sturt University and I knew as soon as I started that I wanted to become a midwife. To me it seemed like such an awesome career.

"After graduating I worked as a registered nurse and quickly enrolled in the Graduate Diploma of Midwifery at Charles Sturt while working in the maternity unit as a student midwife. The uni gave me a great platform to learn in a safe environment, and provided a good stepping stone into my career. That's why I completed a Master of Midwifery through Charles Sturt University. It opened the door to those higher level positions, including my current role as a clinical midwifery consultant for the Western NSW Local Health District.

"The beauty of nursing and midwifery is it can take you anywhere."

Tammy's 'anywhere' turned out to be parts of NSW which rarely received the health and educational support services they required. Realising women in remote areas needed access to antenatal and postnatal care, Tammy has been instrumental in implementing an outreach maternity program.

"I believe it's a basic human right for women to access a midwife during their pregnancy, regardless of their location. Working and living regionally provides me with the opportunity to work within the primary healthcare model of midwifery. It's what I love!"

Courtney Glazebrook is creating new beginnings by treasuring the past. Passionate about First Nations education, she is driven to make a difference in the lives of young Aboriginal children by giving them the best start to their educational journey. As the director of Towri Multifunctional Aboriginal Children's Service, each day, when she opens the Towri doors, Courtney makes practical progress in her quest to cultivate a strong, connected and inclusive community.

"Towri encompasses health, education, community engagement and family support. Early childhood care has such great flow-on effects for families. While we're providing care for children we're also building platforms for parents, giving them the opportunity for employment and better health. We are building the capacity of whole communities. When children thrive so do communities.

"I have the opportunity to create tangible change. What we do, what we teach and what we advocate for directly impacts upon the community and everyone in it. I have learned, through my Charles Sturt University studies and through my career, to question different regimes of truth.

"Aboriginal people are strong. We are connected. We are progressive. And at Towri we are creating new beginnings for those who come through. That really excites me."

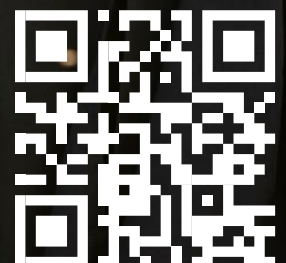

Doctor of Ministry

Helen Margo Crain-Welsby

An Investigation of Non-Muslim Religious Educators' Attitudes, Perceptions and Experience in Relation to Teaching About Islam

The research investigated attitudes and perceptions of fifteen non-Muslim religious educators and their reported experience in learning and teaching about Islam. Participants reported a range of pedagogical initiatives supporting positive perspectives of Islam to counter the influence of media distortions, misrepresentations and stereotypes. Results support the need for further research and the provision of appropriate targeted professional learning for educators.

Peter Woodward

Boring or Divine Encounter - Evaluating the Effectiveness of a Non-didactic Approach to Preaching

This thesis draws upon Tongan cultural customs in order to propose a communal model of supervision for faifekau (ministers) in the Uniting Church. Its Code of Ethics allows for diverse cultures to compose modes of oversight that are particular to their cultures. The relevant paragraph, 1.8, has not been put to such use to the disadvantage of island ministers. The default practice is to privilege a 1 on 1 practice rather than one that is community-based.

Doctor of Philosophy

Alexandra Elizabeth Banks

Broken Bodies, Broken Words: Feminist Theology, Trauma, and the Arts

Alexandra's research engaged with the problematic textual histories of Eve, Hagar, and Mary. Locating her creative practice and theological interpretation within the field of trauma theory, she offers an alternative understanding of living in the aftermath of trauma through the lens of embodied memory. Alexandra demonstrated her findings by creating and permanently installing forty-five faceted glass windows in Holy Apostles Anglican Church Woy Woy.

John David Brunton

Theology in Planning - an integrated theological framework for the planning process

The theologically-derived framework formulated by this interdisciplinary research applies to all phases of the environmental planning process. The matrix recognises relationships across five dimensions of places to enable eight enduring beneficial and desirable characteristics and qualities to be pursued. Implementing this practical tool will promote better outcomes by facilitating effective discussion, deliberation, and decision making when places are transformed.

Ryan David Buesnel

The German State Church Under Nazism: The Institute for the Eradication of Jewish Influence on German Church Life, Die Botschaft Gottes, and the Limits of Contextual Theology

In 1940 the Institute published an edited compilation of New Testament writings titled Die Botschaft Gottes, which was intended to serve as the official Bible translation in Hitler's Reich. Buesnel argues that Die Botschaft Gottes may be interpreted as a work of (negative) contextual theology. He suggests that theologians employing the contextual method should remain cognizant of a priori ethical and theological assumptions that inform their contextual judgements.

Eileen Louise Clark

Snapshots from Mayday Hills: A multidisciplinary study of Beechworth's psychiatric hospital, 1900 - 1995

This work is a study of the former Beechworth asylum. In the research, Eileen explored and recorded the experiences of staff and others associated with the asylum, using interviews and innovative documentary sources. The findings were presented in works about staff, patients and families across different eras. She shows how using skills from sociology, genealogy and history within a unifying methodological and theoretical framework can extend knowledge and understanding.

Sharon Ann Crossett

Representations of femininity and masculinity in Young Adult dystopian fiction

This thesis explores three dystopian series written for young adults. These share a focus on an empowered young female, which has garnered much scholarly attention. Sharon's research is also concerned with the representation of young men in the series in what she calls a "boy-shaped space." Sharon's thesis asks for a more nuanced approach to understanding representations of femininity and masculinity in Young Adult dystopian fiction.

Kaye Elizabeth Ervin

Formal and informal care of people with behavioural and psychological symptoms of dementia: A realist evaluation of research studies in rural Australia

This research focuses on the biopsychosocial factors influencing dementia care in rural Australia. The thesis contributes to the body of knowledge in aged care nursing by proposing improved models of formal and informal care for people living with dementia. The real-world impacts of Kaye's research include enhanced rural workforce skills, decreased use of anti-psychotic medication, and improved management of behavioural and psychological symptoms of dementia.

Letitia Anne Galloway

A study of the impact of the Australian curriculum: History on pedagogical practices of rural New South Wales primary teachers

This thesis examined the impact of the Australian Curriculum: History implementation on NSW rural primary teachers' pedagogical practices. Drawing on the theory of practice architectures, findings established that rurality, lack of equitable and timely access to professional development, and education system policy priorities constrained the adoption of the history curriculum for teachers. Implications for improving curriculum change are explicated.

Penelope Jane Jackson

Writing and Righting: Crime and Copying in Art History

This PhD thesis by prior publication presents the findings and the challenges of researching and writing regarding crime (fraud, vandalism and theft) and copying (both legitimate and fraudulent) in art history. Penelope Jackson's innovative and insightful books *Art Thieves, Fakers and Fraudsters: The New Zealand Story* (2016), *Females in the Frame: Women, Art, and Crime* (2019) and *The Art of Copying Art* (2022) cast light on the 'dark side' of art history.

Liam Bradley Lander

Official Deviance Exposed: An Historical Examination of Political Scandals in Late Twentieth Century Australia

Scandals have long played an important role in Australian democratic politics. History shows that political scandals are often highly consequential public affairs. They can bring down governments, ruin careers, lead to significant sanctions or reforms. Liam's thesis analyses 10 major scandals that occurred in late 20th Century Australian politics. It argues that, under ideal circumstances, political scandals can result in outcomes beneficial to Australian society.

Maina Talia

Am I Not Your Tuakoi?: A Tuvaluan Plea for Survival in Time of Climate Emergency

Those who live on the low lying islands of Tuvalu are among the most vulnerable in the world to threats of rising sea levels and global climate change. Their carbon emissions are miniscule. They are 'weak actors' in terms of the geopolitics of climate change. This interdisciplinary thesis draws upon indigenous knowledge, the ethics of climate justice, insights from climate science, familiarity with discourses surrounding the Anthropocene in order to explore the implications of the parable of the Good Samaritan: am I not your tuakoi (neighbour)?

Natalie Angela Thompson

Talking to children about literacies in and out of school in the 21st century

Natalie's research examined children's experiences of being and becoming literate in and out of school. Guided by post-qualitative understandings of inquiry she used multiple theoretical concepts to write about the conversations she had with 14 children in regional Australia. Natalie found significant gaps between children's experiences with literacies in and out of school and contributed new understandings about the impact of a narrow approach to literacy education.

Rebecca Leanne Hogan

The influence of hedonic and utilitarian motivations on user experience and engagement within the Australian tertiary credit card market

This thesis examines how tertiary students' credit card acquisition and use are shaped by norms, materialism, and shopping values of enjoyment versus usefulness. The findings demonstrate the complexity of credit card behaviour, even with young consumers entering a new stage of their life.

Abdul Quddus Wazirzada

Sustainable Mobility Solution for Road Users Using Intelligent Transport Systems (ITS): Australian Paradigm

Intelligent Transport Systems (ITS) use Information and Communication Technology (ICT) to sustainably enhance mobility on the road network providing increased productivity in the economy. The qualitative research identified world best ITS practice and an alarming gap in its adoption in Australia compared with other advanced nations. The findings of the research contribute to the development of an appropriate strategy for enhanced implementation of ITS in Australia.

Doctor of Information Technology

Alan Leslie Ibbett

An Examination of Real-World Data Leakage from IoT Devices

A Distributed Sensor Network (DSN) was assembled and installed around a high school campus in Australia to measure leakage from IoT devices. Children were trained on how to change their device settings. The DSN again measured the amount of leakage to see if children modified their device settings. The study revealed the amount of data leaked was less than the traffic captured before the intervention, thus the intervention had an effect on children's behaviour.

Linh Dinh Pham

An exploration of non-contact cardiopulmonary measurement using the smartphone in rescue relief events

This research develops a noncontact cardiopulmonary detection method for identifying living humans entrapped under heavy debris. It uses safe frequencies similar to smartphone devices to establish a relationship between the wavelength of vital signs and the trapped human positions and physiological conditions. This method can reduce the average rescue time from a week to a few minutes which significantly enhancing the chances of saving lives during natural disasters.

Doctor of Public Safety

Bradley John Wright

Crisis Event Decision Resilience - the influence of post event scrutiny on during event decision-making

This research considered the influence of post-event public scrutiny on the decision making of commanders during major crisis-events. Results demonstrate that this scrutiny promotes negative organisation and individual behaviour, as commanders seek to follow prescriptive policy and fail to continuously review and adapt. The Decision Resilience Model is an integrated system designed to support optimal during-event decision making and enhance robust post-event review.

Doctor of Psychology (Clinical)

Dawn Christie Haines

Yoga as a Supplementary Treatment for Addiction in the Context of Comorbid Psychosis

The efficacy of yoga as a treatment for individuals with substance and polysubstance use disorders in the context of psychosis and other morbidities was investigated in a public hospital setting. Improvements in emotional regulation, quality of life (physical health), and reduced cravings suggest that yoga may be beneficial in improving aspects of psychological and physical health that support recovery for people with comorbid substance use and psychotic disorders.

Doctor of Philosophy

Nectarios Costadopoulos

Detection of Emotional Stress from Physiological Data using Wearables

The thesis aims to detect individual emotional stress from the physiological data collected through wearable devices and discover knowledge on indicators of emotional stress. It collects real world data from 27 participants using wearable devices and then performs pre-processing of raw data to build decision tree/forest classifiers for knowledge discovery and emotional stress detection. The findings can be applicable to various domains with complex time series data.

Christina Suzanne Farrell

Teenage Girls' Experiences on Social Media: A Discursive Exploration of Institutional Power and Identity Formation

A social constructionist qualitative study explored how teenage girls self-present and self-disclose on social media. A Foucauldian informed thematic discourse analysis produced an Institutional to Individual model illustrating how the sphere of institutional power, cultural ideology, dominant discourses and the systems, drive a focus on individual responsibility, constructing a circular process for the girls of aspiration, dissatisfaction, and self-improvement.

Pham Duy Anh Huynh

Non-market economy status in anti-dumping investigations and proceedings: A case study of Vietnam.

International trading practices that are considered to be unfair may be investigated under rules established by the WTO. The research examines one such practice, known as 'dumping', and finds that exporters from Vietnam and other non-market economies are disadvantaged when allegations against them are being investigated. The thesis provides recommendations to help exporters overcome these disadvantages and identifies ways in which their government can support them.

Muhammad Rafiqul Islam

Video Analytics Focusing on Audio Features Extraction and Rain Removal

This thesis focuses on improving video analytics by addressing the challenges of the noise and environmental factors, such as rain. This research develops novel approaches of video summarisation by extracting audio features and artificial intelligence-based strategy to remove rain from videos by preserving the underlying objects and background. Experimental results demonstrate the effectiveness of the proposed methods in advancing the video analytic technology.

Hassan Jamil

Factors Affecting User's Cyber Security Practices: A study of Australian microbusinesses

Cyber risks are increasing, and businesses have adopted various ways to mitigate those risks. Some of the risks are associated with poor password practices. People are often seen as the weakest link in the security chain. This thesis has investigated the practices of microbusinesses to assess cyber risks. The study included a survey of 502 Australian microbusiness owners, revealing that having a password manager tool is a useful password security practice.

Syed Usman Jamil

Intelligent Task Off-loading and Resource Allocation for IoE Devices in Smart Environment

The thesis presents intelligent task off-loading and resource allocation algorithms for Internet of Everything (IoE) devices. These devices have low computational powers and rely on other devices for computing their tasks such as information retrieval and storage. The proposed algorithms showed significant improvement in computational times and increased system efficiency. This research helps in building smart places for improving the daily lives of people.

Donna Joy Milne

Looking at Me Anxiety: Facial Gaze and Anxiety in Autism

This thesis reported on autistic adults' experiences of anxiety and eye contact, and compared anxiety and personality levels of autistic and non-autistic adults. Autistic adults' experiences ranged from feelings of high anxiety to no anxiety when using eye contact. Gaze anxiety, personality and alexithymia – the inability to feel or understand emotions–were found to interact to increase the likelihood of autistic people experiencing anxiety.

Peita Louise Richards

The Aryan Spring: Twitter and the resurgence of racially-based far right extremist belief systems in the United States of America

Using data from Twitter focused on prominent, racially based events of national significance within the United States, the research critically evaluated how online behaviours may reflect identity and belief systems. Examining the far right the research created original computer code to work through 330 million lines of data; which is replicable for research across social media platforms. The research found online behaviours are the opposite to offline group norms, which extends our understanding of how social media maintains extremist beliefs.

Melinda-Lee Williams

Female Intrasexual Competition: Self-promotion, Social Media, Sabotage and Spending

Women maximise their reproductive success by actively competing with other women to attract and retain high-quality partners and to accrue financial and social resources. This thesis explores how women use makeup, social media, appearance advice, and public displays of wealth and luxury to further their own reproductive goals, while sabotaging the success of rival women. Findings reveal the ubiquitous and covert nature of female-female competitive tactics.

Determining the importance of ramp performance during BMX Supercross: Use of predictive assessments and strategies to improve performance outcomes

Adam's thesis explored the importance of starting performance in BMX Supercross racing. The studies in his thesis evaluated the relationship between start and finish times, examined the role of testing protocols and explored pre-race practices for male and female athletes. He worked with the AusCycling BMX team and Thailand National BMX team to provide novel findings identifying differences in athletic outputs and recommendations towards training practices.

Jake Fountain

The value of on-farm biosecurity for the Australian beef producer

The values that people hold within themselves, that shape their view of the world, will determine their relationship with things around them and how they quantify that relationship. This thesis investigated values of beef farmers in Australia, the diverse role of these values in biosecurity behaviour, and the internal barriers and incentives that can be used to inform the development of effective behaviour change interventions, to improve biosecurity.

Leanne Samantha Greenwood

People, fire, flora, and fungi in semi-arid Australia

Part one: by increasing fire frequency, visible fire diversity, and invisible fire diversity, and reducing fire size, Indigenous people enhance plant diversity and landscape productivity for people. Part two: time-since-fire affects semi-arid fungal communities through opposing direct and indirect effects. Distinct fungal communities can arise under different post-fire successional stages and fire frequencies.

Liam James Grimmett

The application of virtual species to understand how landscape characteristics affect species distribution model transferability.

Simulating virtual species by incorporating population and dispersal processes produces more realistic data scenarios to test species distribution models. These types of virtual species simulated in different landscapes fill their potential niche differently, meaning observed data characteristics also vary between landscapes. These differences in landscape characteristics influence model fit and therefore model accuracy when transferred to novel environments.

Pieter-Willem Hendriks

The Role of Root Architecture and Associated Rhizosphere Interactions in Selection and Breeding for Weed -Competitive Wheat Cultivars

Wheat is a major food crop that can suffer severely from competition with weeds. Pieter-Willem explored one of the sustainable solutions to improve the weed competitive ability of wheat with a focus on below-ground traits. This work included a broad study of wheat root and shoot physiology from the field to the microscopic level. Pieter-Willem demonstrated that it is possible to breed more competitive wheat without penalising the farmer's yields.

Gabriella Hotham

From the sideline to CEO: An investigation into women, leadership roles and Australian rugby league

This study highlights the lived experiences of 30 women working in leadership positions in (male dominated) rugby league competitions in Australia. The participants of this study shared experiences where both subtle and explicit forms of sexism were evident within their workplaces and where they had experienced unwelcoming behaviours from male colleagues and athletes. Despite facing resistance, participants maintained a desire to pursue a career within rugby league.

James Jaeyoung Lee

Application and evaluation of a capillary electrophoresis method for monitoring sugars released from rice starch digestion

Starchy foods are a staple in human nutrition. Understanding starch digestion and its sugar release can be important for health research and food development. This study applied and evaluated capillary electrophoresis (CE) to monitor sugar release during artificial rice digestion. CE was able to distinguish between rice varieties with different digestibility properties. This type of method may benefit industry and research to better understand starch digestion.

Richard Charles McLellan

The ecological implications of the loss of a keystone species: Australian sandalwood, a case study

Australian sandalwood — one of Australia's most iconic plants — is going extinct in the wild. Its populations are succumbing to 175 years of overharvesting, and multiple other severe threats. My research indicates it functions as a keystone species in rangeland ecosystems—providing critical food, shelter, and microclimatic refuge for wildlife, including many of conservation concern. This work has led to sandalwood being added to the global Threatened Species Red List.

Helenna Jane Mihailou

The impacts of feral ungulates on ephemeral savanna waterholes in the Northern Territory and their flow-on effects for native wildlife

Helenna studied the impacts of feral buffalo, cattle and pigs on savanna waterholes in the NT and their flow-on effects for native wildlife. When water availability was low, feral animals visited waterholes more often and for longer. Their presence at waterholes affected how other wildlife used waterholes. Her research demonstrated that feral animals can have significant effects on plants and wildlife in conservation areas and that control measures are needed.

Sangay Wangchuk

Gungtong: An exploration of abandoned houses in Bhutan and links to human-wildlife conflict

The thesis explores the concept of Gungtong, a term used in Bhutan to describe abandoned family houses, often associated with human-wildlife conflict. The study found that stakeholders interpret Gungtong differently, but the perceived implications are consistent with that of rural depopulation. In addition to identifying the drivers of Gungtong, the thesis identified a feedback loop between the drivers and the implications of rural depopulation.

Michelle Williams

Assessing the knowledge gaps and food safety risks for zoonotic bacteria and parasites, focus on parasites, in fishery products imported to Australia

This Thesis examined fishery products imported into Australia for parasites/bacteria which may be a health concern for Australian consumers or a threat to our native fish. Supply chain breaches identified included mud/debris, rusted fish hooks, zoonotic parasites and parasites exotic to Australia and many species of bacteria of human health concern. This Thesis identified that broader testing of some imported fishery products may be required to support consumer health and native fish biodiversity in Australia.
