

## AMALGAMATION

This Thursday, March 31st, 1977, there will be a general meeting at 1.00 p.m. on the Union Lawns. The purpose of this meeting is to decide on the structure of the student organisations. There are 3 student orgenisations, Student Representatives Council, Union Board of Management and the Sports Union. At the end of Spring Semester 176 , there was a. motion put at a. General Meeting to the effect that the S.R.C. and U.B.M. combine. This motion was passed despite the fact that the motion was raised from the floor and that there did not appear to be an adequate quorum. It is due to these facts that the S.R. . . is holding the General Meeting and referendum this Thursday. It is essential that all students at Rivcoll vote on this issue. The Motion for the Meetine is this:
"That at the geiferal student meeting on the 3lst march,
THE FOLLOWING BE PUT TO REFERENDUN:
(a) AMALGAMATION BETNEEN SPORTS UNION, UNION BOARD OF MANAGEMENT AND STUDENTS REPRESENTATIVE COUNCIL.
(b) AMALGAMATION BETWEEN SPORTS UNION AND UNION BOARD OF MAPAGEMENT.
(c) APALGGMATION OF STUDENTS REPRESENTATIVE COUNCIL AND UHION BOARD OF MANAGEMENT.
(d) NO FMALGAMATION.

THE MIMIMUM NUMBER OF VOTES TAKEN AT THE REFERENDUA $3 E$ ECUAL TO THE ZUORUM FOR A GENERAL IIEETING i.e. 100.

THE VOTING NILL こEASE AT 6.00 p.m. TOBY PRENTICE TO BE RETURNIIGG OFFICER.

The S.R.C. has also passed a motion to the effect that they support a proposal formulated by Dr. Cross, the Assistant Principal. This proposal views the most effective form of amalgamation to take place between the Sports Union and the Union Board of Management. The reasons are fairly clear. Both these organisations provide services to the general student body at R.C.A.E. These services cover such aspects as the Food Co-0p., Furniture Market, supply of sporting goods and other retail outlets i.e. the bar etc. Both these bodies are of a basically political nature, whereas the SRC is of a political basis . ad acts as a representative body to the various college boards and committees, for the general welfare of the students. The SRC would act as a type of watchdog over this combined body and would receive the support of the various employees of the Union i.e. Secretary Manager, Activities Officer.

The SRC urges you to vote for alternative (b). This alternative is the most efficient in terms of long range planning. By amalgamating the UBM and $\operatorname{SU}$, a firmer basis for retail outlets can be established under the auspices of the Secretary/Manager and this will only result in better semices for the students a.t Rivcoll.

The only reeson behind the $S U$ and $U B M$ not wishing to amalgamate is that they are both steeped in pest traditions and are not willing to look into the future. With the rapid expension expected at Rivcoll, it is necessary to have student organisations which are effective and on going, and this can be achieved by votine on alternative (b) -combine the UBM and SU.

E11 the full deteils will be put at the meeting on Thursday. Dr. Cross's proposal will be read in full and then it will be up to the students at Rivcoll to vote. As the motion says, the polling booth will be open until $6.00 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{m}$. under the control of Toby Prentice ( $\mathrm{S} .0 . \mathrm{A}_{\mathrm{A}}$ ) A. Athough voting is not compulsory it makes ultimate sense for all students to vote on this issue because you are the ones who are affected.
