Gamaheula bull & cows have been put with the other cows & heifers some time now & another bull put in with them as well. These War census cards are wonderful production have completed them all now & sent them in Tom Coppin's was a beautiful puzzle. I suppose your new manager will have arrived by the time you get this. Expect Louis Sharp here at the end of the week for a few days he has some business at Yauko Irrigation area where he is now & is coming on here. Am sending 42 head fat cattle to Sydney trucking Moundah on 7th Oct., they are pretty good so should bring a fair price. Still getting in grass hay have two mowers

at work now so am making better headway. These started
also sheep walking round boundary to clear the way for fire
breaks. 19 lbs milk last Sunday night, nice warm weather
