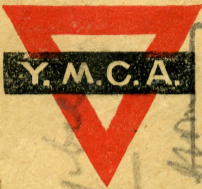
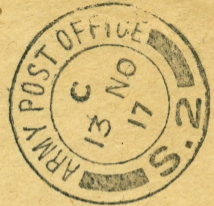

28. 11. 17.

Dear Father

Thanks for your letter dated end of August.
Glad to hear you at last got an acknowledgment
from me of draft sent by you in March last; have
rather been expecting another last two months.
Sorry to hear you have had trouble with lice
on sheep; dipping will mean a lot of extra work.
Rather funny that this last lot of letters I got
should be dated nearly a month earlier than
previous batch. Shearing seems to have been
pretty successful judging by the number of bales.
Also should think the result of the big strike
you had will do good. There is at much news
at present & little time to write just now but
will write again shortly. Am still with 49 eggs
& hope to remain with them. Weather has been
fidgety lately & doesn't look much like clearing
think it is too warm & mild. Very comfortable
here now we are settled in; have a good stove in
our hut with two other chaps & keep quite warm.
Can't write any more at present.
