Review of the CSU Special Consideration Policy and Associated Procedures

Associate Professor Lyn Angel, Associate Dean of Faculty of Science, has been tasked by the DVC (Academic) with chairing the *Special Consideration Working Group* to review the Policy and Procedures associated with Special Consideration. The aim is to

- improve the effectiveness of the policy and procedures to ensure appropriate use by those students genuinely requiring support, and
- improve the efficiency of current processes for providing special consideration.

The Special Consideration Working Group includes:

- representatives from each Faculty;
- representatives from the Division of Student Administration;
- the Dean of Students, and
- the Academic Secretary from the Office of Academic Governance.

A critical part of this review process is to consult with University stakeholders. Therefore, the working group is seeking the opinion of students as a key stakeholder group in this process. We are interested in feedback from students that helps the working group to understand:

- students' experience of the procedures that are used to implement the Special Consideration policy;
- whether students believe the policy is implemented in ways that ensure Special Consideration is accessible and equitable for the student body; and
- whether the special consideration policy and associated procedures support those genuinely in need, whilst making sure this is not abused or misused by those who do not have such a genuine need.

We would really value your views, comments, concerns and suggestions. Your feedback will be provided to the working Group for deliberation and consideration, and to inform the report due for submission to the DVC(Academic) later this year.

Easy Chocolate Cake

Ingredients:

- 1 cup (150g) self-raising flour, sifted
- 1/3 cup (50g) cocoa, sifted
- 1 cup (220g) caster sugar
- 1/3 cup (80g) butter, softened
- 1/2 cup (125ml) milk
- 2 eggs, lightly beaten



Method:

1. Preheat oven to 180°C (160°C fan-forced). Grease and flour or line a 24cm cake tin and set aside.
2. Place all ingredients into a bowl and using a mixer, mix on high for 4 minutes.
3. Pour into cake tin and bake for 35-40 minutes or until the cake springs back when lightly touched in the center.
