OF

C.B.CAMPBELL ESQRE

THIS IS THE LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT of me CHARLES BRUCE CAMPBELL of Cooimbil near Carrathool in the State of New South Wales Grazier.

1. I APPOINT my Father Frederick Campbell my Brother Walter Malcolm Campbell and my Sister Sybil Jean Campbell EXECUTORS EXECUTRIX AND TRUSTEES of this my Will.

2. I DECLARE that in the interpretation of this my Will the expression "my Trustees" shall where the context permits mean and include the Trustees or Trustee for the time being hereof whether original or substituted.

3. I GIVE DEVISE AND BEQUEATH all my real and personal property of every description (excepting and excluding any property which I may become possessed of under the Will of my father Frederick Campbell) unto my Trustees UPON TRUST to sell call in and convert into money the same or such parts thereof as shall not consist of investments of the nature hereinafter authorised.

4. SUBJECT to the payment of my debts funeral and testamentary expenses and any probate or other duties payable on my estate I DIRECT my Trustees to invest in the manner hereinafter authorised the proceeds of the said sale calling in and conversion and to stand possessed of such investments (hereinafter called "my Residuary Trust Fund") upon the following trusts:-

(a) UPON TRUST to pay one-half of the net income to be derived therefrom to my Mother Christina Campbell during her life and during the same period to pay the balance of such income to my sisters Sybil Jean Campbell and Kate Agnes - C.B.CAMPBELL - Witnesses D.W.ROXBURGH - W.P.GARRARD - 1 - Margaret Annabella Campbell in equal shares.

(b) AFTER the death of my said Mother I direct my Trustees to stand possessed of my Residuary Trust Fund Upon trust for my said sisters in equal shares and proportions PROVIDED nevertheless that in case either of my sisters shall die before attaining a vested interest in my Residuary Trust Fund leaving issue such issue shall stand in the place of such deceased sister and take per stirpes and equally between them the share of my Residuary Trust Fund which such deceased sister would have taken if she had survived me and my said mother.

5. I GIVE DEVISE AND BEQUEATH any property which may come to me

through the Will of my father to my brother Walter Malcolm Campbell and in case of his death in my lifetime leaving issue such issue shall stand in his place and take per stirpes and equally between them the property which my said brother would have taken if he had survived me.

6. AND in case of the death of my said brother in my lifetime without issue then I devise and bequeath the said property to my said sisters to be equally divided between them share and share alike subject to the like provision in case of the death of either of my said sisters in my lifetime leaving issue to that hereinbefore contained with respect to their shares of my Residuary Trust Fund.

7. AND I DECLARE that it is my wish that notwithstanding the direction to sell and convert hereinbefore contained my Trustees shall retain any shares I may die possessed of in Cooinbil Limited for such period as they shall think fit. -C.B.CAMPBELL- Witnesses

8. I DIRECT that any moneys liable to be invested by my Trustees may be invested in their names in any of the following forms of investment with liberty to vary and transpose the same from time to time namely:-

(a) Any of the Public Stocks Funds Debentures Treasury or Exchequer Bills Inscribed Stock or other securities of Great Britain or of the Commonwealth of Australia or of any of the States of the said Commonwealth or of the Dominion of New Zealand.

(b) In or upon any freehold securities or upon mortgage of freehold conditionally purchased and conditionally leased lands in the Commonwealth of Australia.

(c) Upon the shares debentures or debenture stock of any Joint Stock Company trading in Great Britain the Commonwealth of Australia or the Dominion of New Zealand.

(d) Temporarily on deposit for periods not exceeding two years for any one deposit with any Bank carrying on business in the said Commonwealth.

IN WITNESS whereof I have to this my Last Will and Testament contained on this and the two preceding sheets of paper

set my hand this third day of October One thousand nine hundred and sixteen.
