Dear Sir.

I thought you might be interested to know
I've had the machine Garvalumb, presented by you.

My old machine was rather badly knocked about
during a scrap over a German aerodrome, & has been
replaced by your machine. It seems a very fine
machine, & has, I think, the best engine I have
ever come across in any machine of this type.

My squadron have only recently come out
from England, but we have already brought down
a good many Germans. My only hope is, that I
shall be able, with your aid of your machine, to
make the number much larger.
