It runs in my mind I had £3000 also invested in the 5^{1/2}% inscribed stock for myself. But this does not belong to that, because of the 3 names. Can it be part of dear Charlie's estate? We can talk about it when we meet. Your brother might like to retain the last news received of dear Charlie from the War Office dated 28th Jan. 1918.
