My dear Walter

Many thanks for your letter sending me
an Egyptian Pen for which I thank you much,
& may wish you a happy new year.

I'm sending a Wire to Gillespie, & was glad
to hear the 37 horns got there as far as Beedkier
altho' they missed their ^{15 1/2 ft} Hay at each end, both
at Morundah & Coolac. I allowed the Railway 4 days,
but they took 8 days to Morundah, & I know not how
long to Coolac. It was too bad.

We have had some 116 Pts of rain, but at Seridewin
there was 500 qts. We may have had enough to
bring up the Wild Helder, in which case the sheep
& cattle will be safe.

I hope to leave tomorrow for Sydney, & shall
stay a few days at the Union Club. I hear the Japs
are building an astoundingly strong navy, which
makes me hesitate buying any kind of Home at
Sydney.
